Who is PSGH?

The Puget Sound Ghost Hunters (PSGH) is a volunteer paranormal investigation and research organization, whose primary goal is to assist clients in identifying and understanding the paranormal activity they may be experiencing.

PSGH adheres to strict procedures and policies to promote successful investigations. All PSGH investigators are fully trained in our protocols and procedures. These procedures are in place to ensure that PSGH provide state of the art investigation techniques to their clients. A reliance on the basics allows us to document paranormal activity.

PSGH conducts regular investigations for clients at private and public locations. The identity of all clients is held in the strictest of confidence. PSGH makes no publication of any investigation location or client information without a signed release from the client.

PSGH does not charge for paranormal investigation services. At the end of investigations, clients receive a report package that includes copies of any evidence collected.

What is a Haunting?



PSGH identifies three types of haunting phenomena.

Residual Haunting: is haunting phenomena which is similar to a recording. By it's nature residual haunting is activity that repeats without deviation and may fade over time. Residual haunting is not aware and cannot interact with the environment.

Active Haunting: is phenomena caused by an intelligence. This can demonstrate interaction with the environment, creating apparitions, moving objects, sights, sounds and feelings.

Poltergeist Haunting: is activity can be extremely violent and is usually of a short duration. Some believe that poltergeist activity may be associated with a specific person in the environment, typically a person undergoing extreme emotional and/or hormonal changes.

PSGH utilizes standard investigation techniques to document paranormal phenomena.

Paranormal Investigations

Utilizing both technical and spiritual resources, Puget Sound Ghost Hunters take ghost hunting and paranormal research into the next phase to promote greater understanding.

Investigations

The primary aim of PSGH in any investigation is to research claims of paranormal activity in regards to reports of haunting or spirit activity and to assist the client in understanding the phenomena they may be experiencing. By utilizing both advanced scientific instrumentation as well as psychic ability PSGH attempts to document and validate such claims. Results of each investigation are compiled for analysis, comparison and review. By only opening investigations to members who are fully trained, PSGH is able to maintain strict adherence to proper investigation and research standards.

PSGH schedules investigations that are client and non-client related on a monthly basis. Non-client investigations are open to all members and can be a useful tool in developing good investigation skills. Examples of non-client investigations include, visits to haunted locations, group discussion events, cemetery cleanup events, field training, research and fact finding trips, as well as any other events. Client related investigations are performed with the utmost professionalism and sensitivity to client privacy. Only PSGH's top investigators are permitted to perform client related investigations.

Client Referrals

PSGH has a large list of possible referrals for post-investigation follow-up. These referrals include health and alternative medicine providers, massage therapists, religious affiliations as well as spirit removal and rescue experts. Clients wishing for services that cannot be provided by PSGH may request a referral.

Research

Research is a large part of the scope of PSGH. With the aid of both online and archive research sources PSGH gathers information regarding past and future investigation sites. In addition, the research department analyzes past investigation data to identify trends in paranormal activity including geographic "hot spots", most commonly reported activity, conducive dates and times for investigations, etc.

The research department works in conjunction with the investigation teams to coordinate experiments and prepare reports and articles that will be released for peer review.
